- 1. Committee Vision and Priorities: Vision and Priorities: Larry spoke about the Sept TED X Talks at the Music Hall specifically a presentation on capturing methane gas and using the carbon for making products that would be a replacement for steel.
- 2. **Website:** will be worked on now that new tax exemptions for solar and wind power have been addressed according to Josh.
- 3. Electric Vehicle Show Report: The alternate source auto show at the lower city parking lot was held on Sept 9 and was well attended. There were over 40 either electric or hybrid

vehicles. The City has taken delivery of an electric car. Dealers will be trained at a fee before they can sell electric cars.

- 4. Wind Energy and Wood Heat Tax Exemptions: Josh reported on the 2003 residential tax exemption for solar and wind energy expanded as a credit against the cost of product and installation on a decreasing basis similar to the expected lifetime.
- 5. **New Building Codes:** Josh also informed us on a new International Energy Conservation & Climate Code. The world will be broken down by zones based on mean temperatures from 1thru 7 NH is 5 VT & ME are both 6 by choice. These will apply to new construction only and consequently raise the costs of building.
- 6. General Sustainability: Bert showed a 3 minute piece from the Sanders Institute titled "What can I do." by Bill McKibben.
