Joanne and I are having a wooden fence installed on our property at 7 Hancock Street. When we were showing our plan to Dick Shea, he advised we needed to send an email to you seeking approval, though he thought the design would meet with HDC approval.

I've attached two photos for the fence.

1. Winchester Picket Fence – Is an even split of 2"x2" small and tall wood pickets. It will span 28' of the side yard from the right, front corner of the house to the Barkers property line. We will have a double gate and a pergola capped archway over the gate in line with the walkway leading into our back yard area.
2. Chestnut Hill Picket Fence -- Is a 2"x 2" (same height as the tall wood pickets in the Winchester) picket fence. It will span 31' from the front corner of Barker's Chestnut Hill Picket Fence following the property line and meeting up with the Winchester Picket fence.

Installation is expected within two weeks.
