- -Library hosted the NELA Info Technology Conference
- -Museum Passes Marketing Push this month
- -Improv 101 Two-Week Course filled up, going well
- -Local History Series continues (2 sessions on the Naval Prison)
- -Author Talk: Reeve Lindbergh, Sunday, June 24, 4-6pm
- -Partnership with high school to allow students to return school library books here and access books on school recommended reading list

#### Other News

- -Library is updating our database of our collections/inventory, working on weeding, improving signage
- -We're looking to partner with Senior Services and/or Portsmouth Housing Authority and others on our book bike proposal
- -Girls Who Code Mollie passed her background check so we are now a registered site, our instructors are getting registered, likely launch in September for a semester

#### **Old Business**

-Vanguard Funds update: there are 3 problems with our transition: we have to match the name of our group with the label of the meeting minutes for the meeting during which we approved the transition; they want a more formal explanation of our status (like articles of incorporation), we sent them the city code establishing the trustees; they want a certificate of beneficial owners (a new form created since we began this process) – Don will try to smooth out these problems; Steve has investigated some other options; money is now in the Piscataqua checking accoun, Piscataqua is offering a special on a 13-month CD; a Morgan Stanley rep has come to visit with offers on various products
