Vice Chair Ferrini noted that the Board of Commissioners meetings are recorded for the Secretary's purpose of editing the meeting minutes. He asked if everyone consented to being recorded, to which everyone in the room gave an affirmative consent.

#### II. READING OF MEETING MINUTES

Commissioner Kennedy motioned to waive the reading of the minutes dated December 11, 2019 and accept as presented. Commissioner Jewett seconded the motion.

Discussion on the motion:

Commissioner Kennedy asked if the issue with the waste water pipes at Feaster is an emergency. Mr. Welch said we are putting a pause on the RAD transaction. We do not have enough information to determine if the waste water pipe issue is an emergency. To get information, we need pictures. We took pictures, which were inconclusive. Commissioner Jewett also took a look at it.

Regarding the postponed motion in December's minutes, Attorney John Bosen said he supports the purchase of 152 Court Street.

The motion carried to approve the minutes, with four in favor. Commissioner Ferrini abstained.

Mr. Welch told the Board about the December 14 Gosling Meadows basements flooding due to bad weather and unused basement vent pipes that were not fully sealed. We answered many emergency work orders.
