1. Grants & Donations:

- a. A grant in the amount of \$49,518 from the New Hampshire Department of Justice through the 'Victims of Crime Act' (VOCA grant). This grant is for expenses incurred and services provided for direct victim services, to include expenses for personnel. (Anticipated Action: A motion will be made to accept the grant in the amount of \$49,518 from the New Hampshire Department of Justice through the 'Victims of

Crime Act', and forward to the City Council for their action.)

b. Procurement of Special Equipment for the Drone Van: The Drone Van requires highly specialized equipment to support the deployment and use of the drones. The cost of this equipment is \$4,150. (Anticipated action: A motion will be made to authorize the use of \$4,150 from the Webber Estate funds to complete the outfitting of the 'Geraldine', which is the Drone Van.) NOTE: In 2019, the Police Commission authorized the purchase of Drones and a Specially Equipped Van from the Webber Estate funds.
