## **Spring Sampling**

CES completed the Spring sampling round with no issues. However when the samples were sent to the lab one of the four coolers containing samples which was sent to Vista Labs in California was delayed due to the carrier taking 4 days when the delivery paid for was guaranteed by 10am the next day. Due to the delay the samples were out of temperature. As a result the samples which were in that cooler are being re-collected. These samples are a mix of residential and OU-2 samples. The re-samples are being collected this week.

## Surface Water and Stormwater Proposal Amendment

The proposal for ongoing surface water and stormwater work has been combined into one contract. The contract proposal is for \$59,250 and it is the recommendation of the technical committee to approve this contract so we can continue work on surface water and stormwater at the site and for compliance with HB-494. ## **Deep Bedrock Study**

CES has begun work to prepare for additional deep bedrock samples and a future pump test. The coordination for that work includes downhole geophysics and packer sampling for M@-6. The downhole geophysics has been completed. The packer sampling work is being planned and will be conducted when the agencies have concurred with the appropriate depths to collect the packer samples from.
