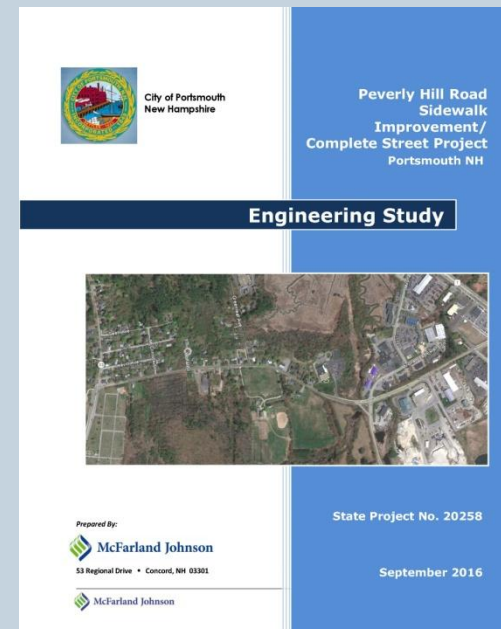






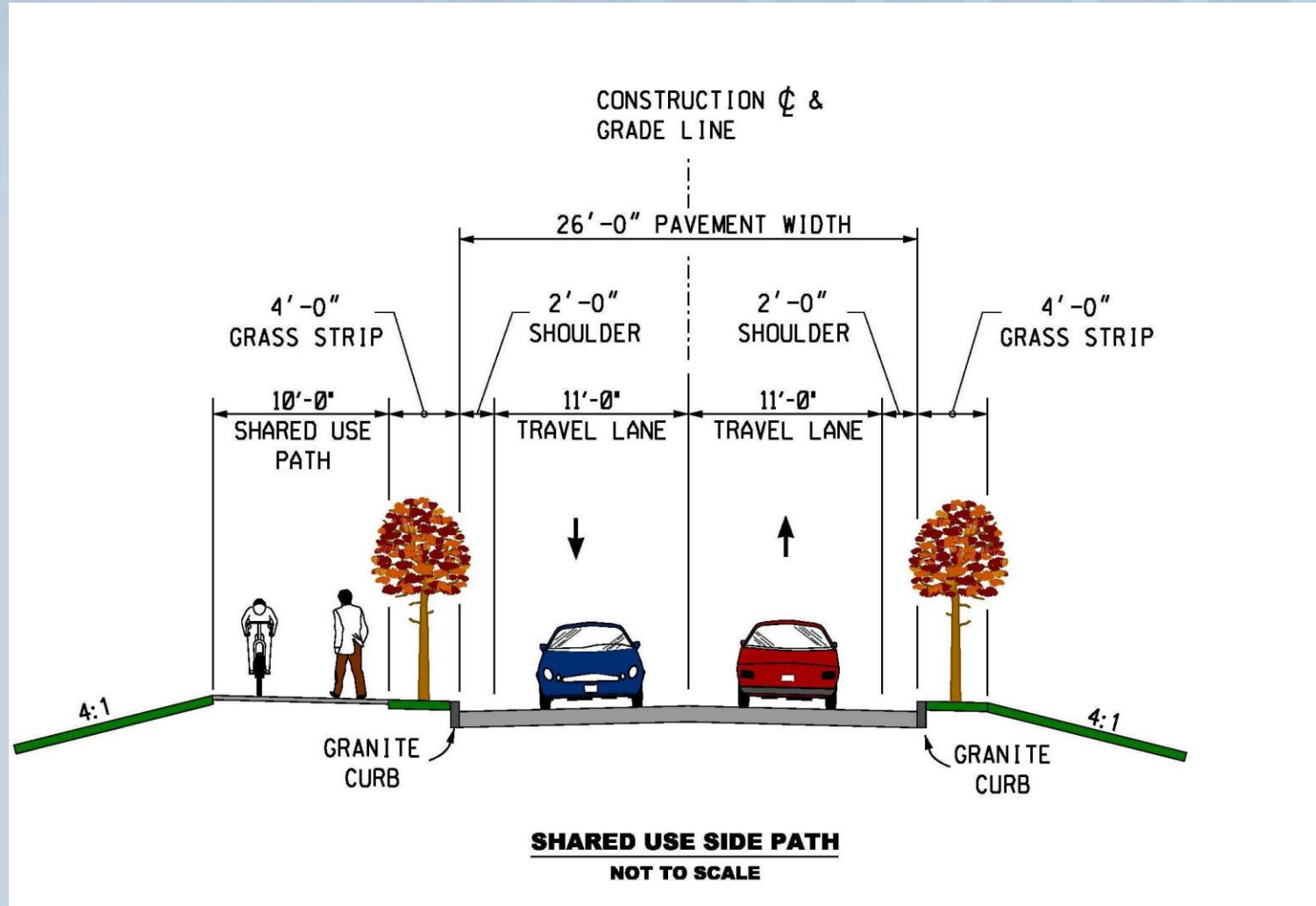

  - Selection of Preferred Alternative





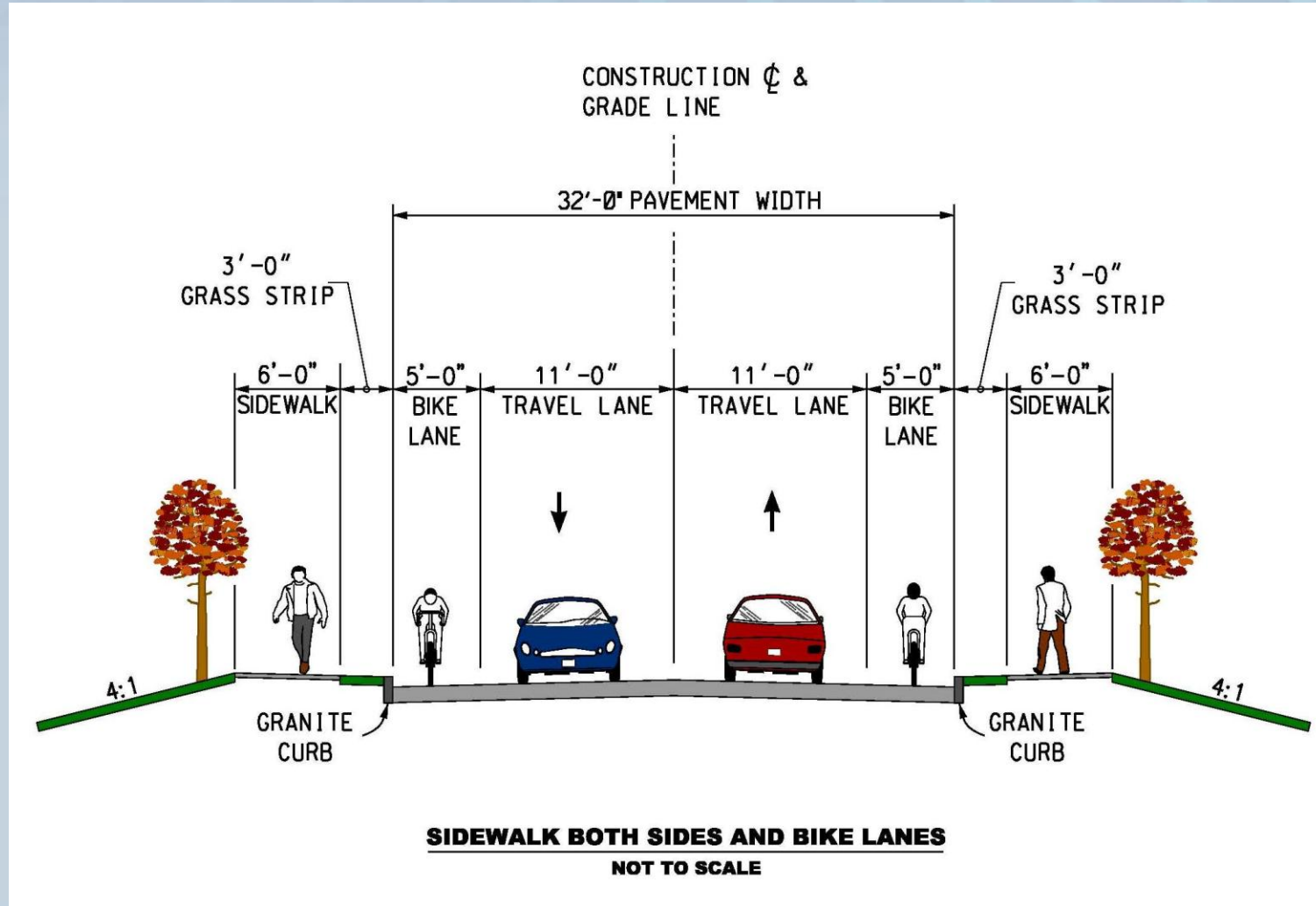
# Conceptual Cross Sections





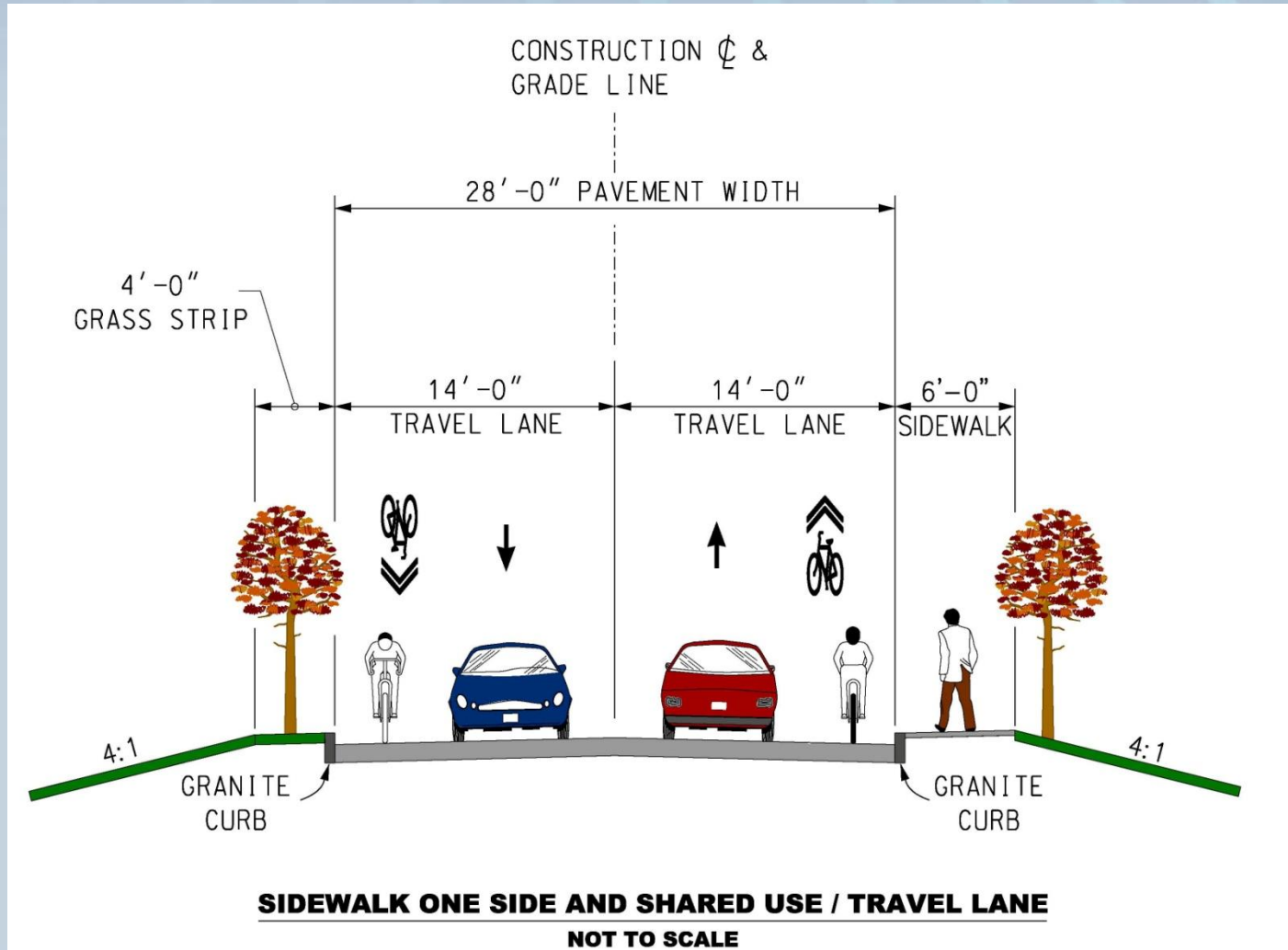
