Letter to HDC for deck addition with storage under at rear of 254 South St.

We are requesting permission to add a deck addition to the rear of our property With storage under replacing all existing material with new weather resistant AKEK waterproof decking and Trex black aluminum rails. All material docs attached. Examples will be brought to the meeting.

We did originally request and obtain permission for a 10 x 10.7 deck addition but are now reducing this to 6' x 10.7 (new plan attached). This gives us less storage but we felt this would blend in more. The total new sqft area to be added is 116.5' not 160'.

We would like to use the TimberTeck AZEK which is fully waterproof and gives us the ability to gain the storage without having to build a separate watertight space under the deck if it were wood. The boards are 3.5" so the same size as the cedar we currently have and look .

We would like to install the Trex black aluminum rails which we feel blend into the surroundings much better. I have included photos of these which are dotted

Our deck is at the rear of a house and mostly not visible from the street apart from the east side which you may be able to see slightly, the flooring material will not be visible at all.


Most of the house is made up of composite materials including the siding and window surround, including the beam surrounds on the rear deck/porch making it much easier to maintain and we feel this would be the same.




254 South ST PROPOSED DECK ADDITION with STORAGE UNDER


