


What is a Bicycle Corral?

A Bicycle Corral is an on-street bicycle parking facility that can accommodate many more bicycles than a typical sidewalk rack. Bike corrals are installed in the vehicular right-of-way along the curb and typically occupy 20 feet (an area equivalent to a single-vehicle parking space) with enough space for 12 bicycles! They are especially useful in areas with narrow sidewalks or areas heavily trafficked by pedestrians, where it would be impractical or obstructive to install a sidewalk rack.



Bicycle Corral Benefits

Expanded and increased parking that serves local businesses

- 10-12 customers can park in a bike corral, the same amount of space required for one car

Increased Business Visibility and Foot Traffic

- Improves sight lines and visibility at intersections for motor vehicle drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists
- Increases the visibility of a business from the street
- Bicycle corrals increase foot and bike traffic
