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




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












#### Sewer Main Break

- Friday Feb 3, 9:30 AM a subcontractor struck a sewer main
- City shut down Mechanic Street Pump Station
- City and Contractor responded with repair crew and septage trucks
- Break repaired at 3 PM
- Resulted in sanitary sewer overflow and a combined sewer overflow at Discharge 10A (South Mill Pond at Parrot Avenue)
- Report is online at portsmouthwastewater.com/piupgrade.html
- Project team is taking precautions to avoid a recurrence

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## Work to be Completed in Coming Month

- Connect phone and internet at the trailer complex.
- Continue underground piping installation near the new Headworks Building.
- Continue installation of reinforcing steel and concrete for the foundation and walls of the new Headworks Building.
- Excavate and initiate installation of the new Sanitary Pump Station.
- Continue installation of utilities near the new Sanitary Pump Station
- Continue excavation and installation of new 12" water main beginning near the pool.

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## Work to be Completed in Coming Month, Cont.

- Continue excavation and installation of new underground power and communications ductbank, beginning near the pool.
- Complete installation of the rip rap slope stabilization on the Shapleigh Island and Piscataqua River side of the site.
- Continue removal of approved trees.
- Continue demolition of the Sand Filter Building (on Shapleigh Island side of site).
- Initiate excavation of the new BAF Building.
- Initiate installation of reinforcing steel and concrete for the foundation and walls of the new Primary Effluent Flow Meter Vault.

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
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
## Work to be Completed in Coming Month, Cont.


- Continue excavation and installation of underground piping near new Gravity Thickener.
