We expect utilization analysis to be conducted from the historical data available from pay and display meters and access and revenue control systems.

10. Will maps be available on the City web site or electronically?

We will investigate making them available through electronic means.

11. Will the selected firm be eligible to participate in future garage design projects?

Yes.

12. When will firms be notified about the September 1st interviews?

We anticipate reviewing RFP's and making selections on August 29th. We will notify selected firms that afternoon.
