Addendum #1 RFP #06-22 – Snow Removal Services Issued Sept. 30, 2021

General

1. Little Harbour School (Clough Drive): Is that maintained by the city or the snow plow contractor for snow plow services?

The school department maintains snow removal and salting of Clough Drive from South Street to the stop sign at Brackett Street. The city does salt the road as part of their salt route during black ice or a light covering of snow.

2. Middle School (Parrott Ave): Can we get a map of the boundary lines? There seems to be a few smaller parking areas connected to the school and we want to be sure we account for all areas included in that scope of work.

Portsmouth Middle School



The orange line is usually the boundary line between the library lot and the school lot. The yellow line is where the school department conducts snow removal for parent and bus drop off. The school

department will salt the library parking lot if they see that it needs it while their salting their lots. Especially the 4 parking spots that are designated for the school department.

The city will plow and salt the library lot. The two circle areas is where the city piles the snow and will hall out during snow removal.


3. New Franklin School (Franklin Drive): Please see attached photo. Are the areas circled in red included in the scope of work?
