Addendum #4 consists of questions asked and answered provided by the Police Department. The questions and answers are as follows:

Questions:

What is the existing LAN infrastructure at each site?

What is the WAN infrastructure between the 2 sites as well as the bandwidth?

What is the monthly call volume at the 2 sites?

Answers:

100mb LAN at both sites, connected by a 1GB fiber WAN.

Call volume is a hard number to nail down. At the RDC, monthly call volume will be small, because it is the back up center. At the Primary center, we handle approximately 3700-3800 calls for service, we do not have the ability to track or count telephone or radio traffic.

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
