 - Liquidated damages will be in the amount of \$1500 for each calendar day of delay from the date established for substantial and/or contract completion.
- 2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 10% of the Total Bid Price.
- 3. The successful bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of his bid.
- 4. Contract award is contingent upon available funds.
- 5. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Invitation for Bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the New Hampshire State Water Revolving Loan Fund (SRF).
- 6. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity as amended by Executive Order 113775" and amendments or supplements to that Executive Order and as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (41 CFR Part 80).
