Scope: This project involves installation of new variable frequency drives (VFD'S). The existing drives are fifteen years old and have failed several times over the last couple of years. Replacement parts are no longer available. The project will also include improvements to the odor control system to the generator system.

- Completion time for the project will be calculated as calendar days from the date specified in the "Notice to Proceed" as follows: 190 calendar days for substantial completion, 250 calendar days for contract completion. Due to the timing and nature of the work, Contractor will be limited to a maximum of 85 calendar days on-site over the entire Contract Period. Liquidated damages will be in the amount of \$800.00 for each calendar day of delay from the date established for substantial completion, and \$800.00 for each calendar day of delay from the date established for contract completion.

- 3. The successful bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of his bid.
