# Introduction of City's Project Team

#### **Bids**

Bids are due 2 P.M. August 29, 2006 at City of Portsmouth Purchasing Department, 1 Junkins Avenue. If bids are mailed, the sealed bid should be enclosed in another envelope.

# **Funding**

The project is funded by the State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan. Requirements that apply include:

- MBE/WBE goal of 8.94% (A-2.6) required 15 days after bid. Certified mail will document solicitation of subbids
- 5% Bid Bond required with bid.
- 100% Performance Bond and Payment Bonds are required on the City forms provided in Section C Special Conditions pages C-2.6 thru C-2.9..
- Retainage is 10% up to 50% completion and held to reach 5% at Substantial Completion. Retainage is 2% for the one-year guarantee period, which starts at Final Completion.
- Federal Wage Rates are not required.
- The City has authorized expenditure for the project. The Project has all the necessary agency approvals to proceed upon receipt of responsible bids.
- Note City Insurance requirements are a little different that the NHDES standard.

# **NHDES Requirements**

The NHDES will monitor construction of eligible portions of the project. The Contractor will need to provide access to the work as needed. The NHDES also has a sign requirement for the project. A copy of the sign detail is included in the specifications. A dimensioned color copy of the sign is available at the NHDES website <a href="https://www.des.state.nh.us/wwe/revforms.htm">www.des.state.nh.us/wwe/revforms.htm</a> and in the specifications.

#### **Project Overview** – The project involves the following work:

- 1070 +/- feet of 2 inch low pressure sewer
- 510 +/- feet of 1-1/2 inch low pressure sewer
- 410 +/- feet of 1-1/4 inch low pressure sewer, and
- Three flushing connections

#### **Questions and Answers**

- Q: Are there any borings for the project.
- A: Yes, see Contract Drawings
- Q: The paving specification indicates that the temporary paving cannot be placed until 30 days after backfilled to allow for additional settling and compaction. Since the project duration is only 60 days and since final paving will be done in the spring after a freeze thaw cycle do we have to wait 30 days.
- A: Agreed, see modification to this requirement in Addenda #1
- Q: The transition from the 2 inch low pressure pipe to the existing 8 inch PVC stub on New Castle Avenue isn't clear. Do you want the contractor to use a 2 by 8 fernco?
- A: No. The detail on Contract drawing sheet C-3 shows a new manhole at the termination of the 2 inch low pressure force main with an 8 inch PVC pipe discharging to connect to the existing 8 inch PVC pipe. The connection between the existing and new PVC is shown as a coupling but may be a normal push-on connection.
