<u>START I</u>

START I is the premier "law enforcement friendly" self aid / buddy aid course on the market today. START I instructors are veterans of not only the EMS community but also have delivered life saving treatment to themselves and others during actual firefights and live fire actions. The instruction students receive during the 4 hour START I certification program is delivered in a manner that only those who have practiced life saving medicine under fire can.

This course is a MUST for the modern day police/safety professional who could be deployed into situations such as the active killer environment where fire department and EMS personnel just will not go into until the shooter is taken into custody or neutralized.

Upon completion of the course, attendees will be issued a self-aid/buddy aid kit (*the kit will contain a tactical tourniquet, Quik Clot hemostatic agent and rescue shears*).

Instructor Bio

Joshua Chiarini (EMT) (HM2 -FMF) (USN Ret.)

His awards include the Silver Star (the nation's third highest award for valor), the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal with Combat Distinguishing Device (Valor); the Combat Action Ribbon; the Navy Good Conduct Medal, the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary and Service Medal. Chiarini is a veteran of three combat tours in Iraq mostly assigned as a combat corpsman with USMC infantry companies in and around the AI Anbar province. He was also a medic assigned to care for the most dangerous enemy combatants at Guantanamo Bay's "Camp X-Ray". Chiarini is a graduate of the military's TCCC instructor course and many other tactical medic courses'. He has been featured on CNN's documentary "Heroes" for his life saving actions while assigned to 2nd Marine Division in AI Anbar in 2006. Petty Officer Chiarini's acts of valor are detailed in Allan Zullo's book "WAR HEROES: Voices from Iraq"

START II

Officers will be empowered and make use of techniques that are "technically sound" and do not rely upon strength, skill or gender. This program prepares officers for the physical, mental and emotional challenges they may face during a violent encounter. Officers will be able to recognize and apply appropriate action during periods of extreme emotional and physical stress after attending this course. The program prepares officers to meet the demands of the encounters both in the field and in the courtroom. They will be able to articulate their actions and apply the necessary techniques in cases of personal attacks, weapon retention, and attacks with firearms. This program prepares officers for violent physical encounters by assailants with mixed martial arts experience and teaches techniques on how to escape mounts, disarms and chokes by violent attackers with formal ground fighting or "cage style" martial arts training.

Pat Watterson is a former member of SEAL Team 8 (Graduate of BUD/S class 207); he has many years of operational experience and training both overseas and stateside. He was a special agent with the Central Intelligence Agency (Global Response Staff – Clandestine Directorate), and is now employed by another government agency where he teaches and instructs on numerous tactics and disciplines.
