# **Public Discussion on Prescott Park Master Plan to be Held**

PORTSMOUTH, NH – The Mayor’s Blue Ribbon Committee on the Prescott Park Master Plan will host a public discussion on Wednesday, January 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the Eileen Dondero Foley Council Chambers. The forum will be televised on the City’s Government Channel 22<sup>nd</sup>.

This public forum will feature a presentation of the draft preferred Master Plan by Weston & Sampson as well as an introduction to the Governance Recommendations drafted by the Blue Ribbon Committee. After the presentations, residents will be invited to discuss the presentation in breakout sessions and a wrap-up of the discussions will be facilitated by Weston & Sampson at the conclusion of the evening.
