Work Beginning on Islington Street and Brewster Street Next Week

PORTSMOUTH, NH – Beginning next week on July 5th, construction work will start on Islington Street and Brewster Street.

As part of the McDonough Street Phase 3B project – involving the replacement all of the existing utility infrastructure (water, sewer and drain) on Brewster, Langdon and McDonough Streets – work on Brewster Street will begin where workers will be setting up a temporary water system. On Islington Street, there are plans to construct a new sidewalk from Essex Street to Plains Avenue that will also include drainage, paving and guardrails. Test pits and ledge removal will begin next week, which will include possible lane closures and traffic control during work.
