Public Meeting on High-Hanover Sidewalk Restoration Project to be held Thursday, March 16th

PORTSMOUTH, NH – In April, the City of Portsmouth will begin the High-Hanover Sidewalk Restoration Project. Bourassa Construction of Stratham, NH has been awarded the bid for this work which includes sidewalk reconstruction and other minor streetscape, pedestrian safety and utility improvements in the areas where the overhead utilities were buried last year.

These areas include:

- High Street - from Deer Street to Hanover Street
- Hanover Street - from Fleet Street to Market Street
- The alleyway between Hanover Street and Ladd Street along the Parking Garage
- Ladd Street from the alleyway to Market Street
- Bridge Street – from Hanover Street to No. 40 Bridge Street

The contractor is scheduled to begin work on Monday, April 3, 2017, beginning on Ladd Street, and proceeding toward Bridge Street. Work is anticipated to be completed by Friday, June 9, 2017, prior to Market Square Day.

Plans and specifications for the project can be found on the City's purchasing web site. A public pre-construction meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 16, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in City Hall's Conference Room A.
