

Executive Sessions

The Board may hold nonpublic sessions but any decisions made during any nonpublic session must be recorded and made available for public inspection promptly, and no orders, rules, regulations, contracts, appointments or other official action shall be finally approved in nonpublic sessions. (RSA91-A: 3)

Nonpublic sessions may be held to consider or act upon the following:

- The dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him/her, unless the employee affected requests an open meeting in which case the request shall be granted. (RSA 91-A:3II(a))
- The hiring on any person as a public employee. (RSA 91-A:3II(b))
- Matters which, if addressed in public, would adversely affect the reputation of any person, other than a member of the body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting.
- Consideration of the acquisition, sale, or lease of real or personal property which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general community.
