WHY: At this meeting, City staff and CLD Consulting Engineers will:

- present conceptual plans for Raleigh Way. Both one-way and two-way traffic circulation plans will be presented and effects on the neighborhood will be described;
- identify specific property owner and neighborhood concerns; and
- answer questions.

The goal of the Raleigh Way design project is to improve streetscape aesthetics, pedestrian safety, and parking. Engineering and design work is expected to be completed by Spring 2007. Anticipated Raleigh Way improvements include a new sidewalk, granite curbing, paving, and street trees. Funding has not yet been allocated to complete improvements.
