PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. Petition of Noble's Island Condominium Association, owner, for property located at 500 Market Street, wherein permission is requested to allow exterior renovations to existing structures and new free standing structures (install miscellaneous signage and a canvas awning) as per plans on file in the Planning Department.
