PORTSMOUTH— The Department of Public Works will hold an April 1 public information meeting concerning planned upgrades to the intersection of South Street at Lafayette Road (US Route 1).

The meeting to discuss the planned traffic signal replacement, repaving, curbing and sidewalk work will begin at 6:30 p.m. in City Hall Conference Room A. The project also includes a widening on the southwest corner of the intersection and on South Street in order to provide a left turn pocket for traffic traveling westbound on South Street.
