

CC 2.0 May Joint Board Meeting Minutes

May 24, 2022

- March and April minutes considered and approved by the Joint Board.
- Legislative update discussed. General attention given to the end of the legislative session, with various Committee of Conference reports up for consideration at final House and Senate legislative sessions. Additional discussion concerning remaining process – enrollment to Governor’s desk to either passage or veto, with discussion concerning the veto timing and process for the legislature considering vetoed bills.
- Discussion concerning various bills sent to Interim Study for the summer, and the timetable when those bills would be taken up for general discussion and committee recommendations for future legislation in 2023 or no further action. Additional discussion on timing of Interim Study reports and bill filing periods.
- Discussion concerning upcoming 2022 elections and candidate filing period in June. Additional discussion concerning various legislators who had already decided whether to run or not seek office in 2022.
- Discussion on potential bills that may return for consideration in 2023, whether from Interim Study bills or new bills, and legislators who may be interested in supporting various policy objectives.
- Review and discussion of draft candidate informational survey to be mailed to all 2022 primary election candidates, seeking their ideas and positions regarding various aspects of state educational funding. Multiple comments and edits to the survey were discussed, including noting that responses submitted may be subject to public review under RSA 910A. Additional discussion to finalize the survey and get it sent out once the final slate of primary election candidates is identified.
- Brief discussion on need to update communication plan and options concerning same.
