I. The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.

Motion by Capone, seconded by Chicooree to move public comment forward due to presence of member of the public. All in favor.

- II. Public Comment. Bess Mosley of Springbrook Condominiums shared with the committee a variety of issues regarding Comcast; those issues included comcast interrupting service for 144 residents without notice; service issues related to modems; choice of channels/package issues, and email storage. In response Capone provided context on the Commission's/City's authority and limitations and the DCM offered to follow up with Comcast representative to communicate the issues of concern. Chicooree and Rodriguez also provided comment and thanks on the issues raised.
