## **Deep Bedrock Study Addendum**

On November 29, 2022 the EPA approved the Deep Bedrock Report and provided a number of follow up areas for the CLG to address. These conditions were included in an addendum which was provided to EPA on March 31, 2023 by WSP. We have not received a response but ongoing work addressed in the original response is underway.

## **GMZ PERMIT**

Work on updating the GMZ permit continues. The new application will include new overburden wells to the West which have been recently installed and sampled. The application will be finalized based on results of data from new wells.

## **Southern Well Installation Workplan**

EPA asked us to amend the work plan to consider creating a single line parallel to the South of North Road rather than installing multiple geophysical lines north of North Road. The geophysics work is complete and the initial review appears to show a suitable location for a southern well has been found south of North Road. However, we are awaiting the final geophysical results which will be provided to EPA to confirm there is an appropriate location to place a Southern well.

## **Water Service Connections**

Property owner at 399 Breakfast Hill Road does not want to go smaller than a 4" line for their fire service protection so we are awaiting a quote from the contractor for the owner on Breakfast Hill Road regarding the cost to install a fire service water line.

## **Surface Water Evaluation**

Submitted to the agencies on April 27 this workplan will address comments specific to surface water groundwater interaction provided by EPA in response to the submitted Deep Bedrock study.

## **Spring Monitoring**

Spring monitoring work is currently underway.

## **OU1 Maintenance Items**

We received the annual mowing contract estimate from Piscataqua Landscaping & Tree Service that will be approved for a total not to exceed \$9,808.96, including grass mowing and brush mowing/cutting of all woody invasive and native shrubs on hill sides down to the fence. Staff expects an estimate for fence repairs within the next week and those are expected to be scheduled after the landscaping work is complete.

## **Landfill Gas Report**

Draft report is under review and will be sent to NHDES and EPA when complete.
