I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

After due deliberation, the Commission voted **6-0** to **approve** the minutes as presented with one member abstaining.

II. WETLAND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT APPLICATIONS (NEW BUSINESS)

After due deliberation, the Commission voted **6-0** *to* **postpone** *this application until the June meeting.*

After due deliberation, the Commission voted **7-0** to **recommend approval** of the application to the Planning Board with the following stipulations:

1. Applicant shall change language on site plans for rain garden to recessed planting area

and provide an update for the total area for planting and the number of plants proposed.

- 2. Applicant shall work with City staff to incorporate changes suggested by the referenced Erosion Control Certified and landscaping experts, into final plan set prior to submission to the Planning Board.
- 3. Applicant shall install permanent wetland boundary markers within the wetland buffer.
- 346 Pleasant Street Mark H. Wentworth Home, Owner Assessor Map 109 Lot 10

After due deliberation, the Commission voted **6-1** to **recommend approval** of the application to the Planning Board with the following stipulations:

- 1. Applicant shall reconsider the use of vinyl material for the fencing.
- 2. Permanent wetland boundary markers shall be installed at the corners of the southern end of the fencing along with markers on both sides of the back fence portion to face the yard and the shore area. These markers shall be installed prior to the start of construction activities.
- 3. The applicant shall provide a maintenance plan for the new fencing that includes power washing with water only.
- 4. If the installment method changes, the applicant will have to apply for a new wetland conditional use permit prior to the start of any work.

III. OTHER BUSINESS

1. Commission Member Updates

Alternate Member Sperduto gave a brief update on her work organizing a course for realtors interested in learning more about flood disclosures, what wetland regulations are in place within the Seacoast area and how to raise a general awareness for owning a home in proximity to a wetland.
