




LITTLE HARBOUR SCHOOL PLAYGROUND





- 2 INTEGRATED STORMWATER FEATURES MITIGATE CURRENT DRAINAGE ISSUES AND INCREASE SENSORY EXPERIENCE
- (3) MOUNDS DEFINE BUFFER EDGE WHILE PROVIDING VISUAL VANTAGE POINTS AND UNIQUE SPACES
- MAIN PLAY AREA FEATURES LANDSCAPE STRUCTURES PLAY EQUIPMENT INCLUDING THE TREE TOPS AND QUANTIS STRUCTURES, 12 SWINGS & 2 SPINNERS
- 5 NATURE PLAY AREA INCLUDES NATURAL EQUIPMENT FOCUSED TOWARD BALANCE AND EXPLORATION
- 6 SAND PLAY AREA ENCOURAGES KIDS TO INTERACT WITH THE EARTH AND GET THEIR HANDS DIRTY
- 7 PLAY FIELD PUSHES SLIGHTLY TO THE NORTH TO ALLOW FOR A MEADOW BUFFER THAT ENCOURAGES STORMWATER INFILTRATION
- 8 ADDITIONAL BIKE RACKS ELIMINATE BICYCLE CLUTTER AND CONSOLIDATE STORAGE INTO ONE AREA
- 9 NATIVE MEADOW BUFFER ENCOURAGES STORMWATER INFILTRATION
- (10) STUDENT MEMORIAL AT BASKETBALL COURT
