The owners of the property to the south of 229 Pleasant St also have a condenser that lacks 10 foot side yard setback. The views of the surrounding properties will not be diminished as each of the surrounding properties has a condenser that also lacks setbacks.

#### Criteria 5

Literal enforcement of the ordinance will result in unnecessary hardship in that another location will be more visible to the public, will result in inefficiencies of operation of this system that will result in greater costs to homeowner and less efficient use of utilities.










