## **APPENDIX A**

### **Fee Proposal Sheet**

#### **Water/Sewer Emergency and Repair Services**

The proposing party hereby offers to provide the City of Portsmouth's Water and Sewer Division with emergency and routine repair services, on an on-call basis, as detailed by RFP#36-18 for Schedules A, B and C below.

#### **General Notes:**

1. The City of Portsmouth has an active contract with a traffic management service. The City will coordinate and pay for traffic control measures with the selected contractor(s) as needed.
2. Excavation and flagging permits will be obtained by the City and there will be no additional charges for these permits.
3. Schedule A and B work generally covers excavation and restoration of activities to the existing grade with gravel. Paving restoration will be conducted by the City or through the rates identified in Schedule C.
4. Work Rate Schedules do not cover all conditions that may be requested. The City and the Contractor may need to negotiate additional prices to cover conditions that do not fit within the stipulated rate schedules.
