The bidder understands that the quantities of work calculated in the Bid or indicated on the Drawings or in the Specifications or other Contract Documents are approximate and are subject to increase or decrease or deletion as deemed necessary by the Portsmouth City Engineer. Any such changes will not result in or be justification for any penalty or increase in contract prices; and agrees that, if the Bid is accepted the bidder will contract with the Owner, as provided in the Contract Documents, this Bid Form being part of said Contract Documents, and that the bidder will supply or perform all labor, services, plant, machinery, apparatus, appliances, tools, supplies and all other activities required by the Contract Documents in the manner and within the time therein set forth, and that the bidder will take in full payment therefor the following item prices;
- 6. It is the intention of this contract that the items listed above describe completely and thoroughly the entirety of the work as shown on the plans and as described in the specifications. All other items required to accomplish the above items are considered to be subsidiary work, unless shown as a pay item, to wit:
 - 7. This project will be bid as lump sum. Work Items include:
 - a) Scrape all existing exterior painted surfaces to remove flaking paint using lead safe work practices.
 - b) Renail clapboards as needed. Replace failed clapboards and trim in kind.
 - c) Apply glazing compound to muntins of exposed double hung windows as needed before painting.
 - d) Spot prime all bare wood surfaces after scraping.
 - e) Caulk perimeters of clock faces with paintable silicone caulking.
 - f) Caulk wood joints in open air bell tower with paintable silicone caulking.
 - g) Seal holes in copper roofing above the clock level with silicone.

i) Prep and paint all wood surfaces 2 coats latex paint.		
j) Paint Roof above clock, and belfry roof with copper compatible coating.
