Question 1: Can you provide us with a full-resolution version of this photo that I'm attaching below? It would be very useful in order to place a rendering of our proposal in its environment.

Answer 1: Unfortunately, we cannot provide a specific high resolution version photo.

Question 2: Is there a timeline for installation?
Answer 2: The installation schedule will depend on artists' timeline and weather conditions.

Questions 3: Can you provide more site information for the Art Commission?

Answer 5: The footbridge is between the main parking lot and a footpath which passes by the site.

Site elevation is approx. 30' above sea level

Proposed site location approx. $65^{\prime} \times 55^{\prime}$ Elevation above sea level is $30^{\prime}$
§ Nearest parking lot/footbridge with trail to site is approx. 125' from proposed site
Children's playground is approx. 120' from proposed site location

-     - Stone dust and dirt trails

Footbridge is about 62' long over a slightly marshy area
Bluff to north of site is approx. 50' above sea level. Playground approx. 50' above sea level.
