Members of the Portsmouth Police High Intensity Drug Interdiction Team (HIDIT) and Detectives arrested the following individual on July 25, 2014:

Mr. Ireland was a target of the HIDIT and was arrested without incident on the steps of the North Church in Market Square on a warrant alleging Felony Sale of Oxycodone. Mr. Ireland was booked and held on cash bail and will be arraigned on Monday morning.

Portsmouth Police continue in their multi-pronged effort to combat opiate addiction and dealing in the City.

REHABILITATION:

Police recently partnered with the community providers to provide access to drug rehabilitation as well as an amnesty box for those struggling with addiction on July 12th. The next Community Access to Recovery event is tentatively scheduled for September at Portsmouth Regional Hospital. In addition, Portsmouth Police remain an active partner with Rockingham County Drug Court.

ENFORCEMENT:

Police formed the HIDIT in order to target street and mid-level drug dealers operating in Portsmouth to crack down on those who profit from the addictions of others. Mr. Ireland is a drug dealer in Portsmouth and was targeted for that reason.

EDUCATION:

School Resource Officers will continue in their efforts this fall to provide children in our community with positive and honest messages regarding illicit and prescription drug dangers.
