tons recycled + tons composted total tons of waste generated

Recycling Rate = Diversion Rate

 EPA reports: "In 2013, Americans generated about 254 million tons of trash and recycled and composted about 87 million tons of this material, equivalent to a 34.3 percent recycling rate."


Portsmouth average 55% diversion rate over the last 10 years; 22% composting and 33% recycling

**Diversion Rate Comparison** 







Compared to the average American, the average Portsmouth resident produces less than half the amount of waste because we understand the importance of reducing and reusing materials










2005 was the first time we recovered more material than we landfilled
